

## **Implementing provisions**

### **of the Regulations governing the admission of applicants to the University of St.Gallen [IP AR]**

of 14 May 2019 (with amendments of 24 March 2020)

Pursuant to the Regulations governing the admission of applicants to the University of St.Gallen (AR) of 21 June 2019

the Senate Committee of the University of St.Gallen

hereby issues the following implementation provisions<sup>1</sup>:

#### **I. Managing Climate Solutions**

##### *Art. 61a Admission requirements*

<sup>1</sup> Admission to the Managing Climate Solutions certificate programme can be granted to applicants who

- a) are studying at the Master's Level of the University of St.Gallen,
- b) obtained an academic degree at the Master's or Licentiate's Level from the University of St.Gallen at an earlier point in time,
- c) hold a recognised Master's degree (or an equivalent diploma) in economic sciences from another university.

##### *Art. 61b Admission criteria*

<sup>1</sup> The following documents have to be submitted with the application:

- a) a concise curriculum vitæ,
- b) a concise letter of motivation,
- c) current Bachelor grade transcript or Bachelor diploma supplement.

<sup>2</sup> The programme management defines the maximum possible score per admission requirement. If necessary, it may define additional criteria for registration.

<sup>3</sup> The applicants with the highest scores are admitted according to the course places available.

##### *Art. 61c Admission with a time limit*

<sup>1</sup> Students who fail to attend "Climate Solutions 101" in the first semester of the programme will be excluded from the programme. It is incumbent on the programme director to check on this.

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<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to Art. 123 of the University Statutes (Consolidated Statute Book of the Canton of St.Gallen No. 217.15), only the German version of these Regulations shall be legally binding.
